

# GRADES 10 & 11 ONLY

## Cooperative Work Experience (CWE) Opportunity\*



You have the opportunity to take a career preparation course by taking the Cooperative Work Experience class. This class will prepare you for your future career. You also have the ability to earn up to 1.5 credits by completing an unpaid internship during the second semester in the field of your interest (completed during class time).

- Semester 1: 0.5 Credit for Intro to CWE (classroom-based instruction - career research, resume writing, cover letters, interviewing skills, employability skills, labor laws, worker safety);
- Semester 2: 0.5 Credit for 50 Internship Hours OR
- Semester 2: 1.0 Credit for 100 Internship Hours

This class can also be used for Mastery Credit Experience for an additional credit.

*\*You must be 16 by the end of January 2025 to participate in the internship part of the program and must have your own transportation (yourself, your parents/family, etc.)*


